At present, there are 14 Nursing Colleges in the State of Maharashtra and have 363 admission seats in all P.B.B.Sc. Nursing colleges. The ratio of the P.B.B.Sc. Nurses to the population of Maharashtra is 1.42735. At present there are 10 P.B.B.Sc. Nursing Colleges having only 263 admission capacity in Rest of Maharashtra region. Hence, it is desirable to grant permission to start a new P.B.B.Sc. Nursing College with annual intake capacity of 30 (Thirty) students at "Dr.J.J.Magdum Institute of Nursing Education, Jaysingpur, Tq.Shirol, Dist. Kolhapur" in State of Maharashtra.

Kolhapur" will fulfill the norms and conditions laid down by the Nursing Council of India, New Delhi and will not employ / engage any teacher from the Government Nursing College except on their retirement at superannuation.
